Admission Requirements

- 1. Candidates must hold a Bachelor's degree in any suitable field from a program guaranteed by the Office of Higher Education Committee with a GPA of no less than 2.50 and/or 2 years of work experiences.
- 2. Candidates must pass the English Proficiency Examination administered by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University or have a TOEFL score of no less than 480 or an IELTS score with a minimum of 4.5
- 3. Exceptions to the above items may be made by the Program Committee.
